The Transit Authority (TTA) transportation system will be free for Marshall University students, faculty and staff the entire month of September 2005. According to TTA's manager, Vickie Shaffer, "the free introductory offer is to familiarize the students and faculty with the ease and benefits of commuting to the MU campus on the TTA transit system." Ms. Shaffer points to the rising cost of gasoline and inconvenience of parking tickets as the major benefits for MU riders.

MU bus riders can ride free by showing the bus operator their MU ID card. Dial-A-Ride customers are asked to let the dispatcher know they are MU riders when they schedule their trip and show the van driver their MU ID when the Dial-A-Ride van picks them up.

TTA has promoted free September transit services for Marshall University students and personnel since 1997.
